2026 Farmer's Market

- 2026 Staunton Farmer's Market: Confirmed fit for a Community Guest table under current market rules
- Market relocation pending due to Wharf construction → details still flexible, but guest tables expected to remain
- Market Manager indicated Queen City Sovereignty Salon is welcome in the community-guest rotation
- Positive informal feedback from vendors and board members on our mission and approach

 - Repair Clinics





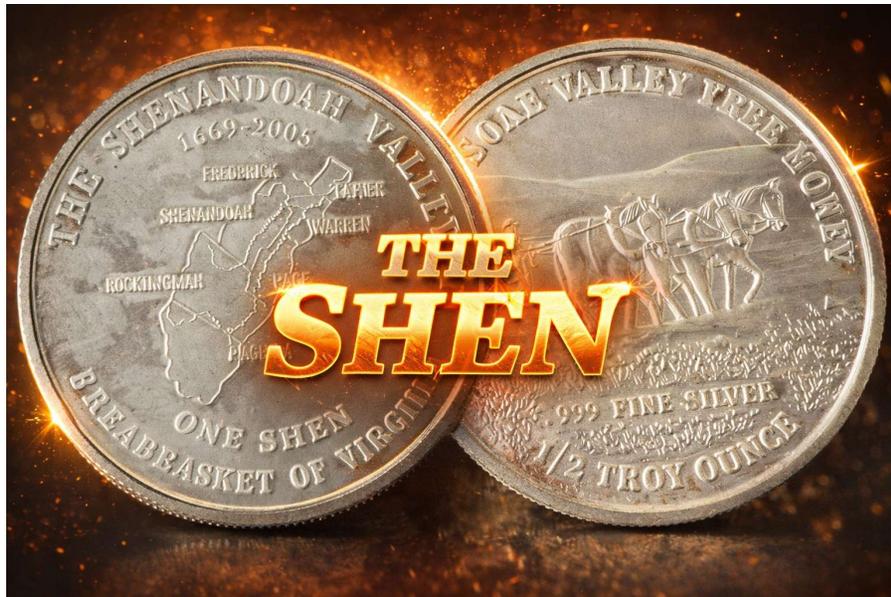
Keeping Time, Locally

Tech & Social Media

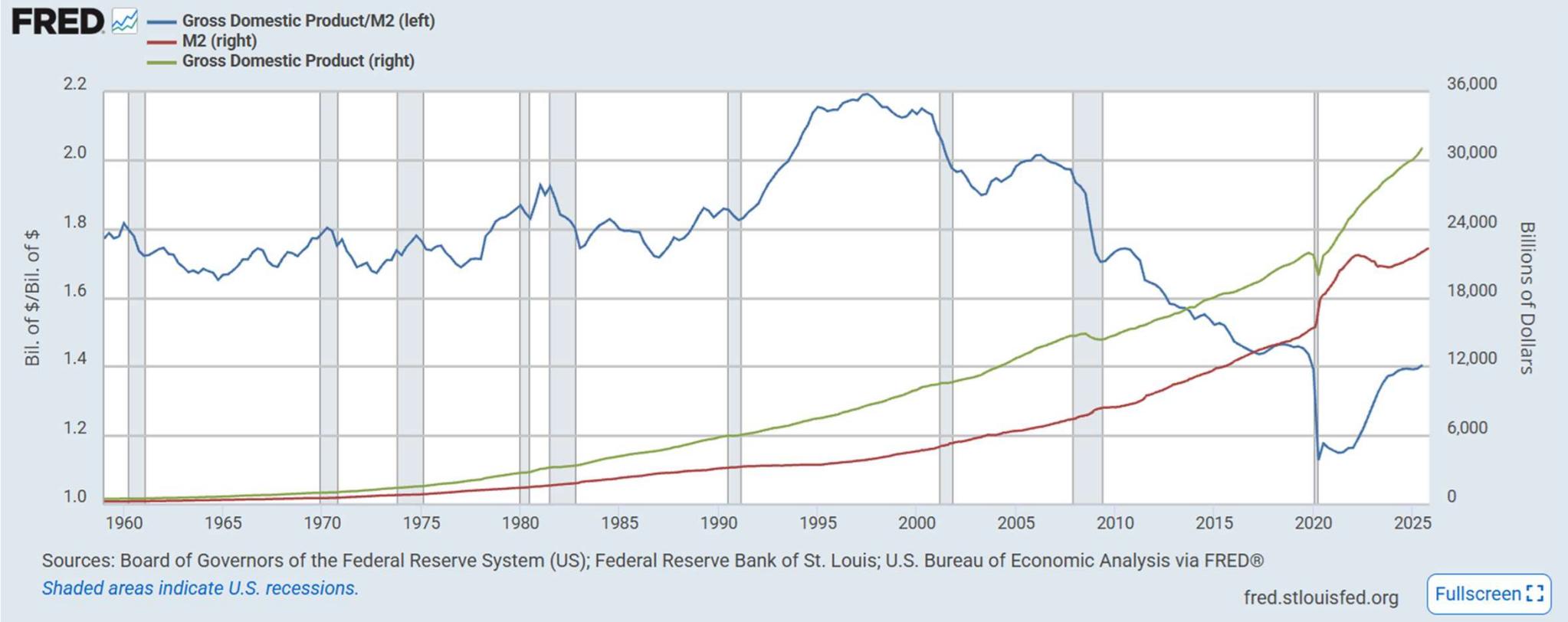
- Legacy Social Media is very problematic
 - Data harvesting leading to individualized price discrimination
 - Privacy concerns
 - Algorithmic rage baiting
 - AI-slop reality distortions
 - Explicit and implicit tax breaks for technocrats, but not regular folks
- Other options exist!
 - Nostr (I'm biased)
 - Qortal
- Local tools should run on local infrastructure:
 - Hosting our own services
 - Running our own nodes
 - Maintaining communication channels
- Older or donated hardware:
 - Refurbished desktops
 - Retired office machines
 - Low-power devices that would otherwise become e-waste

Money & Control

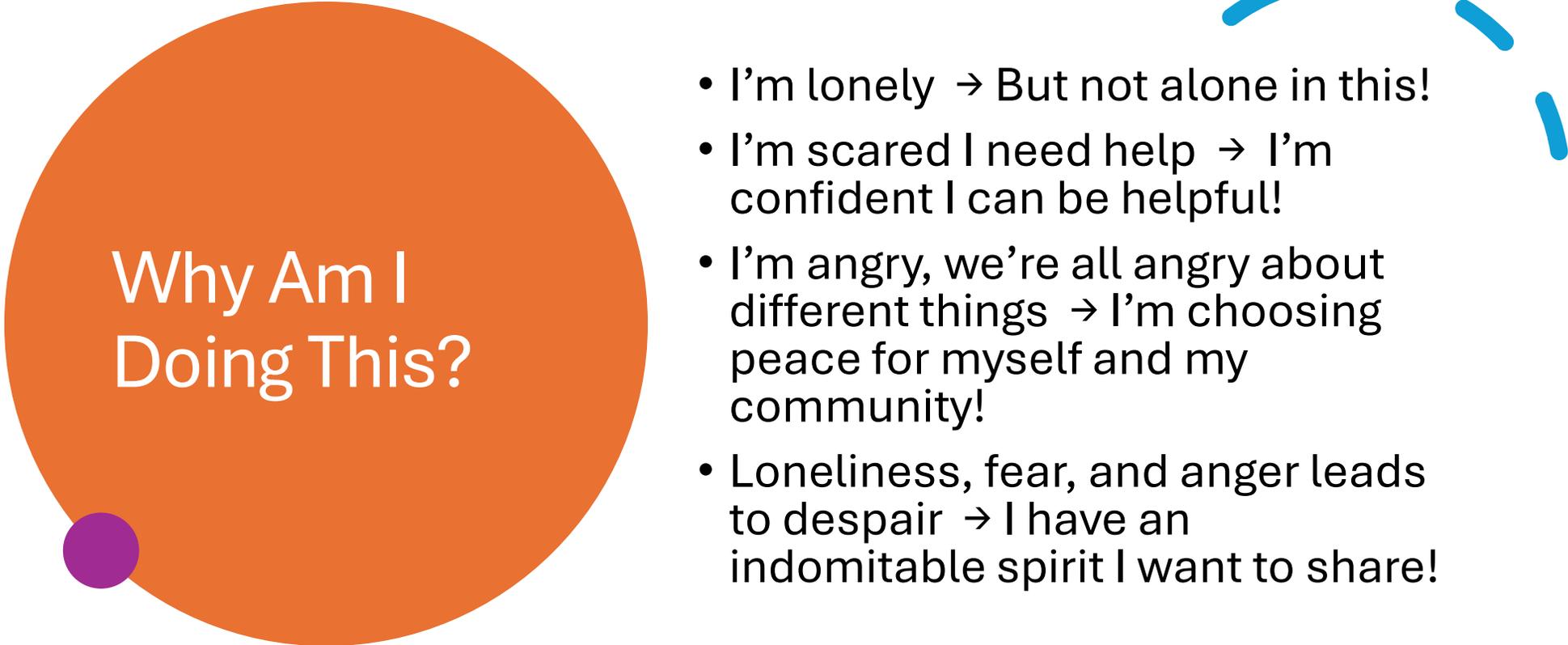


- Physical hOUR time bank tokens → very possible
- Local goods exchangeable collectable currency → gets complicated fast, but possible
- Nostr → opportunity to baby-steps into bitcoin without substantial investment upfront
