hOUR Economy (Local Time Banking)

A mutual exchange network where one hour of service equals one hour of value. Skills become currency. Neighbors become collaborators. <https://houreconomy.org/>

Repair & Skill Clinics

Extending the life of goods. Sharing knowledge from gardens to gadgets.

Mesh Radio Communication

Low-cost, decentralized communication tools (e.g., mesh networks) so neighbors can stay connected during outages or emergencies.

Freedom Tech & Open Tools

Exploring open-source platforms that reduce reliance on centralized gatekeepers.

Why Local Resilience Matters

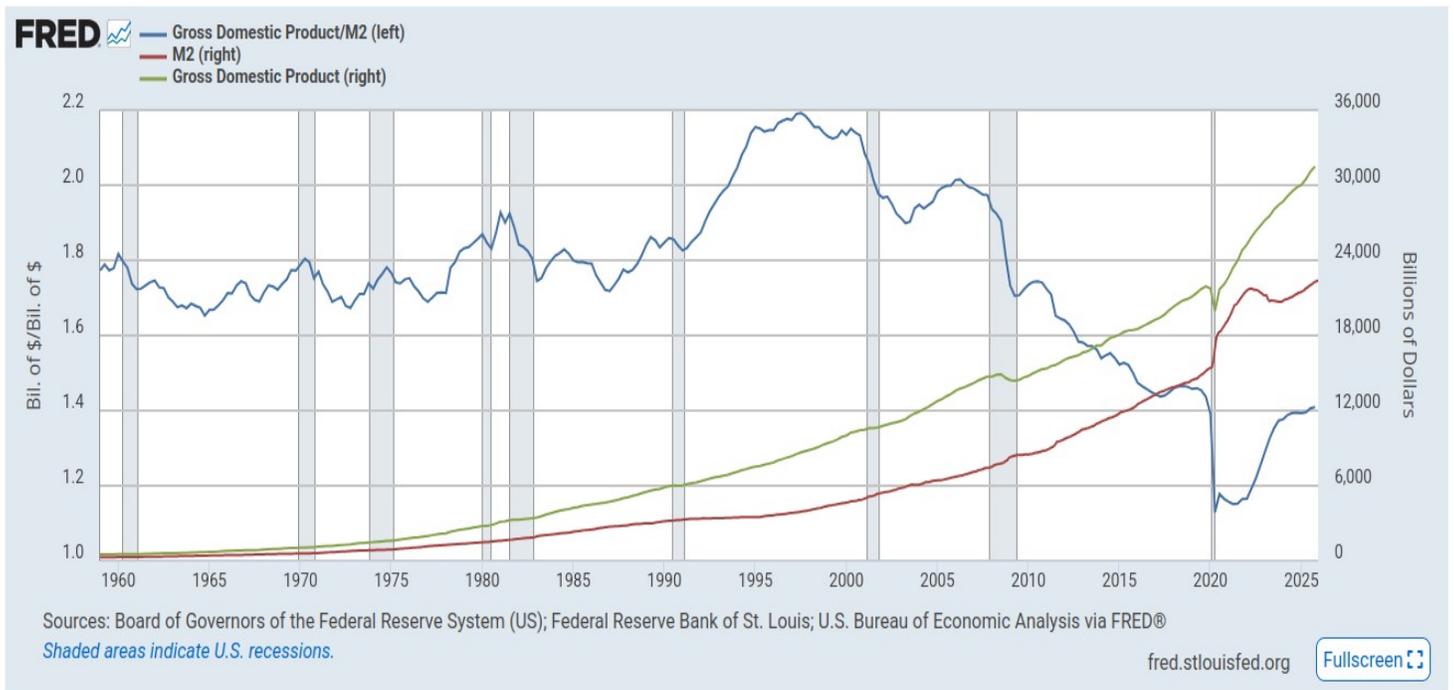
Do you ever wonder how one income used to support a household, while today many families work multiple jobs and still feel stretched?

Why does GDP grow, yet purchasing power often feels weaker?

Why supply chain disruptions, storms, or system outages can leave communities scrambling?

Why skills go unused while neighbors' needs go unmet?

You aren't imagining it. The economy has changed.



Expansion of money supply relative to economic output weakens purchasing power over time.

But communities can adapt. Together we can make things better!

Resilience: the ability of a community to function even when larger systems fail.
