

## Death of 45-year-old man still being investigated - Herald-Times (Bloomington, IN) - June 28, 2006

Bloomington police and the Monroe County coroner's office are investigating the death of a 45-year-old man over the weekend.

Donald "**Kenny**" Rush was found dead inside his home, in the 500 block of West Seventh Street, on Saturday.

Coroner Dave Toumey said an autopsy was performed Monday in Terre Haute, but a cause of death had not been determined.

Authorities will have to wait for toxicology results to come back in four to six weeks before coming to any conclusion, he said.

"It's still an ongoing investigation right now," Toumey said.

Meanwhile, police would not reveal any details surrounding Rush's death.

Attempts to reach Rush's family were unsuccessful Tuesday.

Bloomington Police Capt. Joe Qualters said Tuesday that the department was still investigating the incident.

"We are working with the Monroe County coroner's office in an effort to resolve some questions that arose during the initial investigation and subsequent autopsy," Qualters said.

"The investigation will include reviewing toxicology results, which will not be available for several weeks. Any conclusion as to what led to the death would be speculation until the investigation has been completed."

No other information about the investigation was available.
