

# ● Moving USDT From Revolut to 9M

Want a friction-free way to move USDT from Revolut to your 9M account? Follow the clicks below and you'll only do the fiddly bits once.

## 1. Grab your 9M Wallet address

### 1 In 9M:

- Go to **Assets** → **Deposit**.
- Choose **USDT** and set **Chain Type: Matic**

2 Copy the long wallet address - it **must** start with 0x....

## 1. Add that address to Revolut (one-off setup)

### 1 In Revolut:

- Tap **Crypto** → **Send** → **Tether (USDT)**.

2 Select **Add wallet address**.

3 Paste the 0x... address you copied from 9M.

4 In the dropdown, pick **Wallet** (not exchange).

5 At the top, start typing **9M**.

6 Tap **Add manually**.

7 Complete the form:

- Provider's name:** 9M
- Wallet type:** Private wallet
- Label:** e.g. 9M - AB (Matic) - use your initials.

8 Press **Continue** (Revolut may ask you to paste the address again) and then **Save**.

Your 9M wallet is now stored in Revolut for future transfers.

## 1. Send USDT

1 Back in **Crypto** → **Tether**, choose your new **9M wallet**.

2 Enter the amount and confirm the send.

## What happens next?

- Once the AI check clears and the transaction is on-chain, 9M will credit your account automatically.
- Future transfers are simpler: start at **Step 3**, pick the saved wallet, and send.

That's all it takes to keep USDT flowing from Revolut to 9M without the usual guess-and-check. Happy transferring!
