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# Win-Growth Portfolio Matrix

Classify each business unit and assign differentiated mandates



## HOW TO APPLY

- 1 List all business units with revenue, margin, and growth rate
- 2 Plot each on the matrix using market growth (x) and competitive strength (y)
- 3 Assign each to a cluster: Growth, Value, Protect, or Divest
- 4 Define differentiated KPIs and capital allocation rules per cluster
- 5 Review annually. Positions shift as markets evolve
